Superfast Broadband:

Coverage in Loweswater:

No plans for coverage in Phase 1 of the rollout, but areas around Loweswater are currently in plan for the next phase. It can't be confirmed yet until full planning and costings are done but it's looking good.

Coverage in Mockerkin- it looks likely that they are served by the Lamplugh exchange. There is a lot of work currently going on to upgrade the Lamplugh area, but I don't think it will cover Mockerkin in Phase 1. However Ullock (and additional areas served by the exchange) is currently in scope for Phase 2, as is Loweswater. The current plan is to add new cabinets and do what's called copper rearrangement (effectively "rewiring" of exchange lines to improve coverage), but there is still a lot of planning and costing to be done and confirmed. It could be positive news for Mockerkin, but suggest people register interest via Connecting Cumbria website and they will be updated.

Mockerkin Update:

The green is being cut on a regular basis, The bench is still awaiting repairs. Light opposite dancing Pastures still out of action. Good feedback on the new light.
