Notes:

Mockerkin street-light: Met with David Bryden from Allerdale BC and he has agreed that the light in Mockerkin should be replaced. He will need the agreement of the land owner to the placement of a new pole next to the ENW pole that the light was originally on.

Mockerkin Green: After a visit to the Common Land Records Dept. in Carlisle the status of Mockerkin Green has become clear. The land was registered as 'Common Land' in 1968 by Mr. J.B. Sergeant, the Clerk to Loweswater Parish Council. The registration number is CL159. The registration was undisputed and became final in August 1972. In 1976 a right of way across the land was granted to access the adjacent dwelling. All 'Common Land' in Cumbria falls under the oversight of Cumbria County Council. Mockerkin Green is not a registered village green and is not owned by the Parish Council (no one owns registered 'Common Land').
